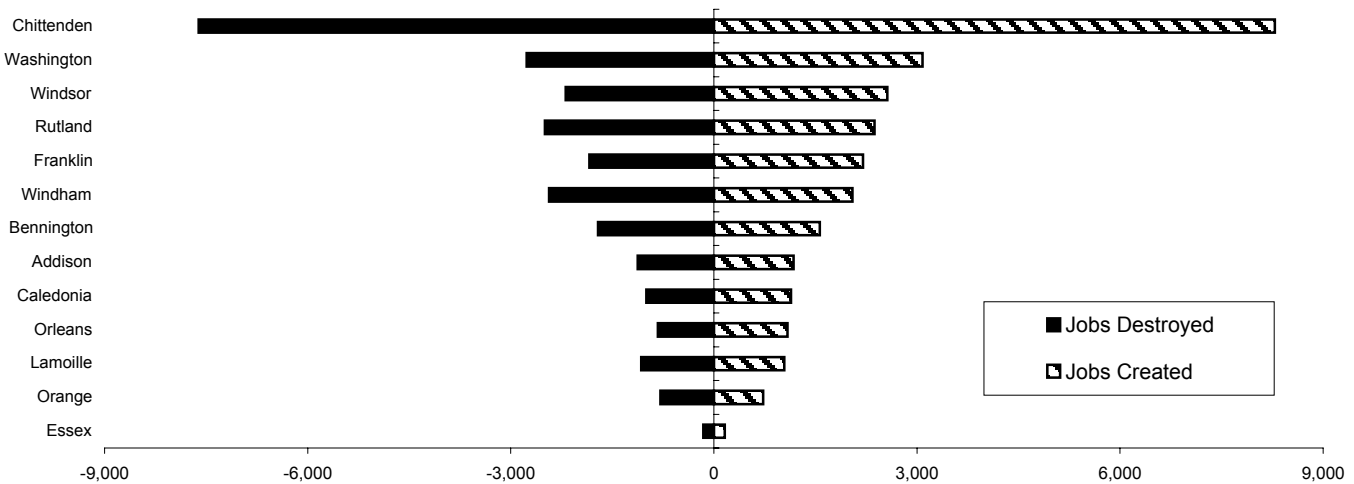
Job Creation and Destruction by County between 1st Quarters 2003 and 2004

Claiming the largest share of employment, Chittenden County dominated all other counties in gross changes and overall job effect with an increase of 679 new jobs. Franklin, Washington, and Windsor Counties were next with gains of more than 350 each. Orleans County boasted the largest percent change and the highest replacement rate. The overall job affect of Windham County was the lowest with a drop of 387 jobs.
