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INTRODUCTION

Licensed and Certified Occupations in Vermont 2015 is a guide to occupations requiring licensing or certification by the State of Vermont. This publication is a resource for students and individuals exploring careers as well as people planning on moving to and working in Vermont.

This publication is a compilation of licenses or certifications issued by the State of Vermont that are required to practice or be declared qualified in an occupation. Not included are business licenses issued by the state and licenses issued by Federal agencies or local municipalities. For each license or certification there is a brief description of the work licensed or certified, required exams, fees, reciprocity with other states, number of licenses, occupations affected and contact information including a website, if available.

All information is current as of September 2015. For complete and the most up-to-date information regarding fees, examinations, and requirements for licenses, certifications, and registrations for the listed occupations, please **contact the appropriate licensing board or agency**. The Vermont Department of Labor cannot provide you with more information than is available in this publication.

Individuals planning on entering a training program or educational facility in order to practice in a licensed or certified occupation should contact the licensing board or agency to ensure the program meets State of Vermont standards.

TERMINOLOGY

The terminology used in regulating occupations can be confusing - some occupations are licensed and others are certified or registered, some licenses are available through reciprocity, others by endorsement. What is the difference? These terms and others are defined below.

Licensing, Certification or Registration

Licensing is the statutory process through which a person meets the legal requirements sufficient to be permitted by law to practice an occupation in the state. Applicants must meet certain requirements involving training, experience, minimum age, years of education and/or evidence of good moral character.

Certification, similar to licensing, "certifies" individuals to engage in a regulated occupation. Completion of an approved instructional program is a common requirement. Other requirements may include successful performance on a qualifying exam or completion of work experience.

Registration is a general term sometimes meaning regulating an activity, similar to licensing, or simply registering individuals engaged in an occupation. In the latter case, only listing one's name and address and payment of a fee is involved.

Reciprocity or Endorsement

Reciprocity denotes a relationship between two states where state "A" gives the subjects of state "B" certain privileges, on the condition that subjects from state "A" shall enjoy similar privileges at the hands of state "B". In other words, "you give people from our state licenses and we will give people from your state licenses". A licensure system based on reciprocity requires the authorities of each state to negotiate and enter agreements to recognize licenses issued by the other state without further review of individual credentials.

Licensure by endorsement is used by state boards to grant licenses to professionals licensed in other states that have equivalent or more stringent standards. States may require additional qualifications or documentation before endorsing a license issued by another state. Professionals seeking licensure by endorsement may need to submit an application, original transcripts, letters of recommendation and fees to the state board for review and approval. Each state retains separate disciplinary authority over its licensees. Endorsement allows states to retain their traditional power to set and enforce standards that best meet the needs of the local population.

O*Net Occupation

O*Net is an occupational information program with a database containing detailed analysis of worker attributes, such as knowledge, skills, work duties and activities. Based on the Standard Occupation Classification (SOC), occupations in this publication are defined by the 2010 O*Net-SOC. More information is available at www.onetcenter.org/usingOnet.html.
